We are pleased to confirm your club affiliation with USPSA/IPSC for the year 2009. We hope you will continue to be satisfied with the many benefits that United States Practical Shooting Association can offer you in the coming year.

One of those benefits is the opportunity to hold classification matches for your members using the USPSA National Classification System. We are now using the 4th edition of the National Classification Course Book, presently with 67 stages from which to choose, both for your monthly classification courses and for your Specials. Only the classifiers in this book are authorized to be used this year. Please check the web site under Classifier Stage Diagrams for the most current changes, additions and deletions to the classifiers.

Also included is an application for SCSA club membership; if you have been thinking of adding Steel Challenge to your activities or had a complimentary club membership this past year, you are eligible to become a Steel Challenge affiliate at a reduced (dual-club) rate.

To assure your club of proper activity credit, and especially as a courtesy to your shooters, we ask that you report your activities **promptly** after every match to USPSA Headquarters at Sedro-Woolley as well as to your section coordinator. We use the activity points to determine the number of slots to the various U.S. National Championships, and how they are distributed. If you have any questions about your paperwork or if you have problems with the computer scoring program, please call the USPSA office at Sedro-Woolley.

Remember, too, that you can report the results of your matches electronically through our web site! If you e-mail Roger (roger@uspsa.org) at headquarters and provide him with your club name and code, he will be able to assign you a password for your uploads.

Your affiliation and activity fees help support our programs and make USPSA more responsive to the people it serves. On behalf of myself and the entire USPSA staff, thank you for your dedication in making our sport one to be proud of. Please be sure to put both the Sedro-Woolley office and the Chino, California office on the mailing list for your club newsletter. We do enjoy hearing from you.
